You must apply for an extension, which are considered on a case by case basis. You must remain with your preceptor(s) at all times. All preceptors must be listed on your application.

Please be advised that this clearance is only for observation at Parkland Health. If you would like to observe at Clements University Hospital, (UTSW) they have a separate Observation Program application process.

When picking up your Observer badge, you may park in the Tower Garage adjacent to the new Parkland hospital. You may also take DART that has a station on the hospital campus.

The Badge department is located in the Logistics building directly behind the hospital. They are open Mondays from 1330-1600 and Tuesdays-Fridays from 0730-1600. **Please make sure to take your driver's license or passport. An Observer badge will not be issued without a form of identification.** ***Present this email to the Badge Departmental Systems Specialist as confirmation that you are clear to obtain your Observer badge. <u>Your Observer badge must be worn at all times</u>. Please return your Observer badge at the conclusion of your Observation experience.

While in the Badge department, information can be obtained about where to park during your Observation.
